Cardiology for the Primary Care Provider is designed to provide practical and helpful review of cardiac problems commonly faced by the primary care physician. This year's course will focus on the work-up of chest pain, cardiac risk factor evaluation and management, atrial fibrillation, and peripheral vascular disease. For each topic the speaker will cover initial management and work-up, when to refer to a specialist, and long-term management considerations.

Lectures will be conducted in an informal manner and questions are welcome. Attendees are encouraged to ask practical questions relating to their day-to-day practice. Attendees will receive a syllabus summarizing the key points from each lecture. CME units are provided: one unit for each hour of attendance.

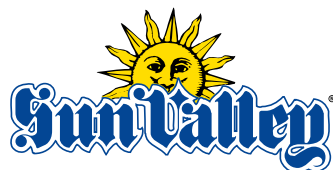
