

## 2009 ACP Minnesota Poster Event Format and Schedule

Find the poster boards labeled with your group letters. Set up your poster in any of the spots for your group (example A1-A 5 for group A). You can set up your poster any time after noon. Please bring your own pins to the event.

At the assigned time below, the groups will meet their judge in the poster hall, Group A meeting at A1, Group B meeting at B1, etc. Each presenter will have five minutes to present her or his case, and five minutes to discuss it with the group. After each poster has been presented and discussed, the judge will select one poster to advance to the next round. This is based on the criteria given to you and the judges previously. If you are selected to advance, do not move your poster, but go immediately to the second round location designated below to meet your new group. If you do not advance, the judge should give you written or verbal feedback. **In addition you are still eligible for the people's choice award.**

While there are substantial prizes, this event is meant to foster communication, learning and collegiality, not competition. Thank you all for participating.

- A. People's Choice/Open viewing time... NEW THIS YEAR!
  - a. People's Choice Award. All are eligible! Every conference attendee (including residents and students) can cast one vote for whichever poster they choose. The poster with the most votes wins the award and \$200. Tie breaker goes to Dr. Lohr, the ACP Governor.  
**Voting deadline 430 PM.**
  - b. Public viewing of posters from 330-400. All meeting attendees will have a break from lectures at this time. They are encouraged to view your poster and vote for the People's Choice award.
- B. Vignettes
  - a. Round 1 230-330, if selected to advance, proceed directly to...
  - b. Round 2 330-430, if selected, your poster will be moved for public viewing and...
  - c. Round3 430-500, the final round judged by the ACP College Representative
- C. Research
  - a. Round 1 330-415, if selected to advance, proceed directly to...
  - b. Round 2 415-500, the final round
- D. Medical Student
  - a. Round 1 230-330, if selected to advance, proceed directly to...
  - b. Round 2 330-430, the final round

## People's Choice/Public Viewing

**Leave your posters up!** From 330-400 there will be no lectures and all conference attendees will be encouraged to view your posters and vote for the People's Choice Award (\$200). From 400-430 there is time for residents to evaluate and vote on each others' posters. Every attendee has one vote and the deadline for voting is 430 PM. Tie breaker goes to Dr. Lohr, ACP Governor.

## First round times & locations:

Groups A-Z, meet at 230, at the first number of your group, e.g. group A meets at A1; group B at B1

Groups 1R-3R, meet at 330, 1R meets at 1R1, 2R at 2R1, and 3R at 3R1

Groups 4MS-6MS, meet at 230, 4MS at 4MS1, 5MS, at 5MS1, and 6MS at 6MS1

**NOTE: Group Z will be meeting at 2 PM and not 230**

Groups F-J meet at F1 at 330

Groups K-O meet at K1 at 330

Groups P-T meet at P1 at 330

Groups U-Z meet at U 1 at 330

Groups 1R-3R meet at 1R at 400

Groups 4MS-6MS meet at 4MS at 330
