

Alfred Stengel Memorial Award for Outstanding Service to the American College of Physicians

The Alfred Stengel Memorial Award was established by the Board of Regents on April 27, 1947. The award honors Dr. Stengel, a Regent and President of the College for two terms.

This award is bestowed for outstanding service to the American College of Physicians.

The recipient shall be a newly elected, or previously elected, Master of the ACP, preferably one who has served as an Officer, Regent, or Governor and who has completed official service. The selection shall be based upon unusual loyalty and exceptional contributions to the aims and purposes of the College, as well as the recipient's outstanding influence in maintaining and advancing the best standards of medical education, medical practice, and clinical research.
