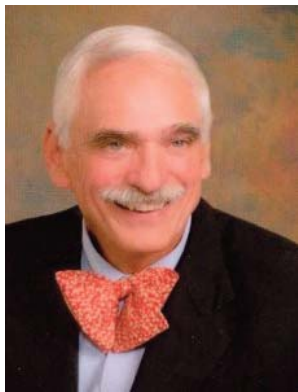


Nicholas A. Califano, MD, FACP

Dr. Nicholas Califano graduated cum laude "with distinction" from the University of Rome in Italy, after which he completed a medical residency at Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital in Philadelphia, a fellowship in

gastroenterology at Rhode Island Hospital, and a research fellowship in biological sciences at Brown University.

Dr. Califano is currently on the active staff of Rhode Island Hospital and Roger Williams Medical Center in their departments of medicine and divisions of gastroenterology. He also serves as a consultant to Women & Infants' Hospital. He has served on many hospital committees and currently is a member of the IPA of Rhode Island Hospital, and Lifespan IPA and PHO Finance Committee. He is also active on several state committees, including Board of Director, Federal Hill House; Impaired Physicians Committee of the Rhode Island Medical Society; and the Impaired Physicians Committee of Rhode Island Hospital.

Dr. Califano has been president of the Rhode Island GI Society, the Bristol County Medical Society, and the Rhode Island Society of Internal Medicine. He is now a member of the Providence Medical Society, Rhode Island Medical Society, American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, American Medical Association, New England Endoscopy Society, Biliary Study Group, and

Advisory Carrier Committee of the American College of Gastroenterology and the American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy. He has achieved fellowship in the American College Physicians (FACP), and American College of Gastroenterology (FACG).

As clinical associate professor at Brown University, Warren Alpert Medical School, Dr. Califano develops curricula and teaches all aspects of gastroenterology to medical students, residents and fellows. He is a practicing gastroenterologist and managing partner with University Gastroenterology in Providence, RI.
