

# Executive Proclamation

## State of South Dakota

### Office of the Governor

*Whereas*, Dr. Ruben Bareis is an icon of internal medicine, geriatrics, and medical ethics in South Dakota; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis has mentored generations of South Dakota physicians throughout his medical career, and retired 10 years ago after a long, successful medical career in internal medicine; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis remains active on the Advisory Board of the South Dakota Foundation for Medical Care and the Rapid City Regional Hospital Medical Ethics Committee, and continues to attend the annual meetings of the South Dakota Chapter of the American College of Physicians and the South Dakota Medical Directors Association; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis is an advocate of the "Comfort One" system in South Dakota, in which persons can enroll in order to assure they are not resuscitated against their will; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis continues to teach the Interdisciplinary Palliative Care course at the West River Campus of Sanford School of Medicine in Rapid City, a required course for medical students in their last 2 years of study; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis earned one of the first Certified Medical Director designations from the American Medical Directors Association (AMDA), is credited for starting the South Dakota Chapter of AMDA, and in 1988, passed his Certificate of Added Qualifications in Geriatrics the first year it was offered; and,

*Whereas*, Dr. Bareis has few opportunities to celebrate his birthday, being a February 29, 1928, leap year baby, and it is fitting and proper that the governor recognize this outstanding citizen on the occasion of his 20<sup>th</sup> or 80<sup>th</sup> birthday, whichever he so chooses to celebrate:
