Brian T. Hurley is a native of South Dakota. He graduated from Canton High School in 1965 and South Dakota State University in 1969. From 1977 to 1980, Dr. Hurley practiced Internal Medicine at Central Plains Clinic in Sioux Falls, SD. He is currently Professor in the Department of Internal Medicine and Chief of the Division of Pulmonary Medicine at the Sanford School of Medicine at the University of South Dakota.
