



Cervical Cancer



Invasive cervical cancer can assume a variety of appearances. In this image, a dark mass appears on the ectocervix, but may protrude from the cervical os, or the cervix may appear densely white. Bimanual examination will reveal an enlarged, firm, sometimes immobile cervix.
