



## Common nevus



A nevus, or common mole, is a benign proliferation of normal skin constituents. It may be flat or papular, commonly has sharply demarcated borders, a soft, rubbery texture, and generally regular pigmentation with usually no more than two shades of light brown or tan. As they age, nevi may lose their pigmentation and resemble basal cell carcinoma. This image shows multiple regular, tan flat nevi on the legs.
