

Volunteerism and Community Service Award

The Volunteerism and Community Service Award was initiated to honor members of the West Virginia Chapter who have distinguished themselves in voluntary service in the area of medicine.

Awardees must be Masters, Fellows, Members, or Associates of the College. Self-nominations are not permitted. The service must have been performed on a voluntary basis and not required for the completion of teaching, training, or position requirements. Volunteer work must have been done as a physician and be medically related.

Award recipients will be eligible for nomination for the **Oscar E. Edwards Memorial Award for Volunteerism and Community Service** presented by the American College of Physicians each year at Annual Session.
