

Internal Medicine Training

Prerequisites for training include completion of a four year medical school (MD or DO), and undergraduate college level prerequisite courses required for acceptance into medical school.



Internal Medicine Residency Training

3 YEARS

Internal medicine physicians complete at least 3 years of internal medicine residency specialty training following medical school.* At that point, they are eligible for board certification in internal medicine. To become an internal medicine subspecialist requires an additional 1-4 years of subspecialty fellowship training.

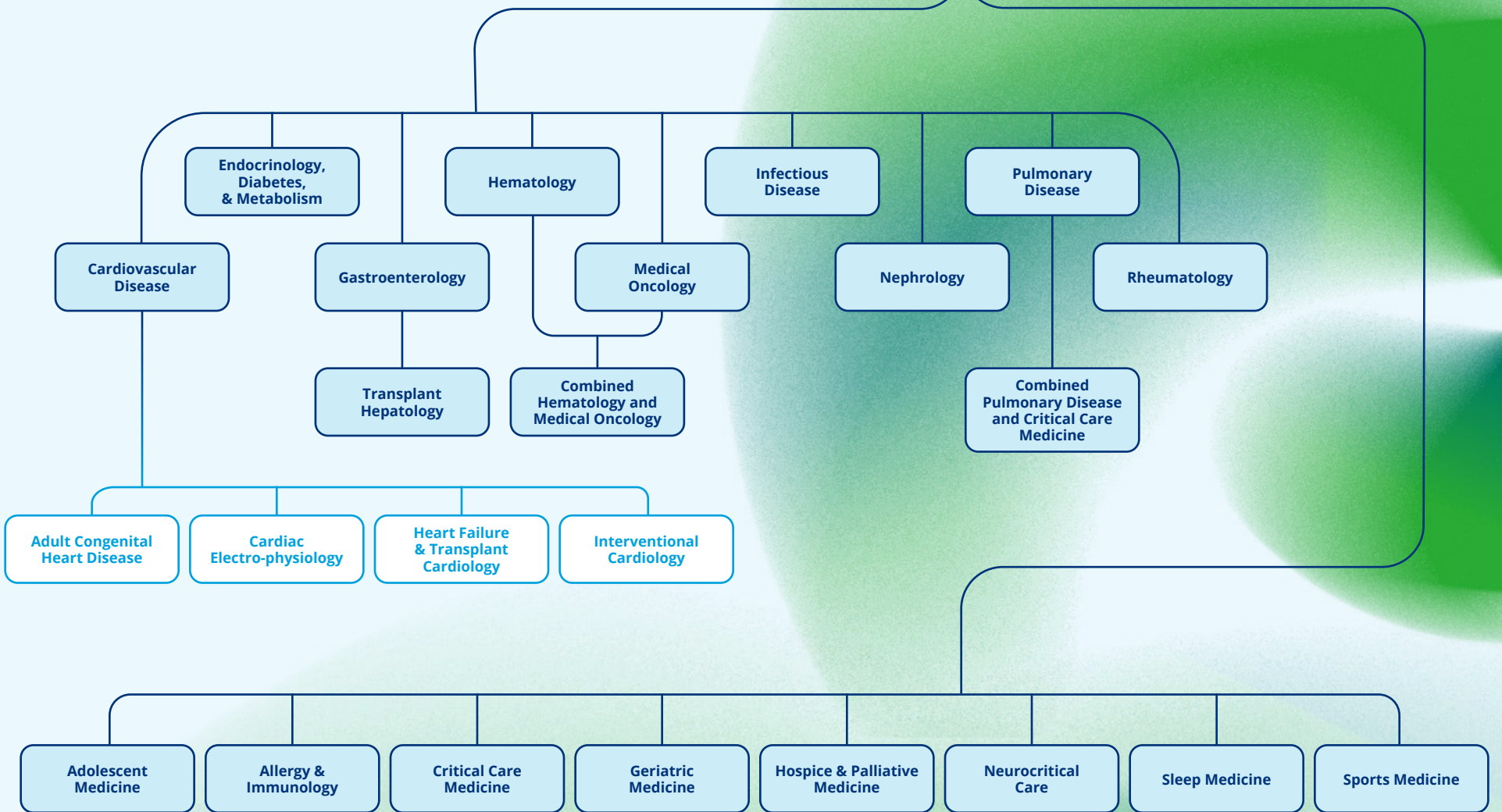

Trainees are eligible for board certification in a subspecialty area of internal medicine following completion of fellowship training. Many fellowship training programs may include a research component.
