The judged ORAL presentations will be held Saturday, November 17, 2018 at 1:30pm (program subject to change). There will be three oral presentations (up to 15 minutes to present with at least 5 minutes for Q&A).

There will also be a judged electronic poster session.

Eligibility/Instructions

- 1. Open only to resident and student members of the ACP Atlantic Provinces Chapter.
- 2. First authors <u>must</u> be a Medical Student or an Associate (resident/fellow) Member of the ACP Atlantic Chapter or have made official application for membership in order to submit an abstract.
- 3. You are to be currently enrolled as a student in a faculty of medicine in the Atlantic Provinces or enrolled as a resident in a postgraduate residency training program in internal medicine or subspecialty fellowship training program in the Atlantic Provinces.
- 4. The person submitting the abstract must be the primary author and the person who will present.
- 5. The abstract word limit is 450.
- 6. All patients must consent. And any patient information and/or images must be anonymized.
- 7. Please provide 2-3 learning objectives along with your submission (not part of the word count).
- 8. Cases are to be submitted in WORD via email only to christiane.acpcanada@gmail.com.
