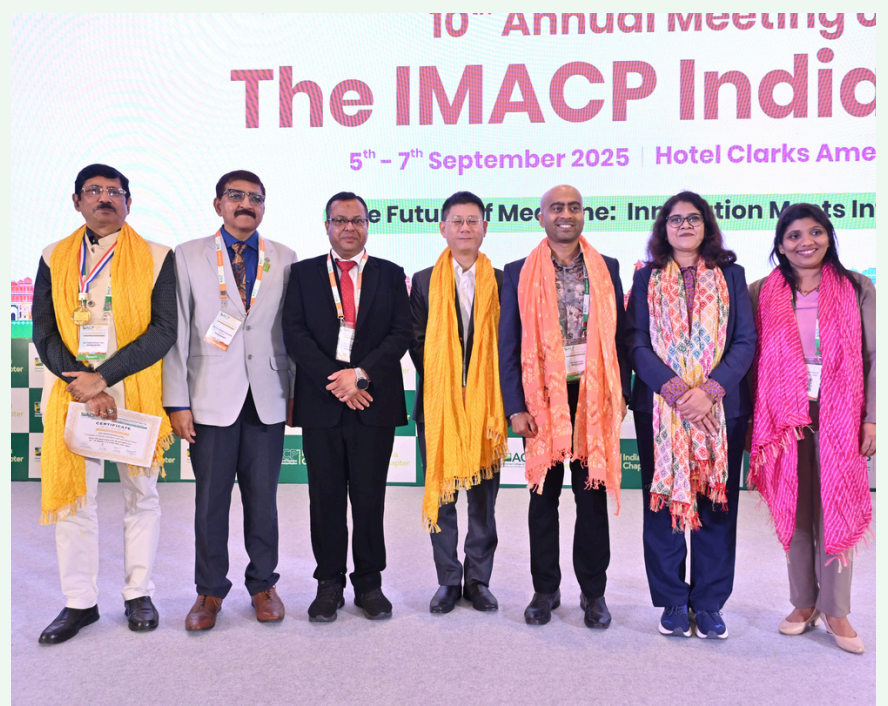

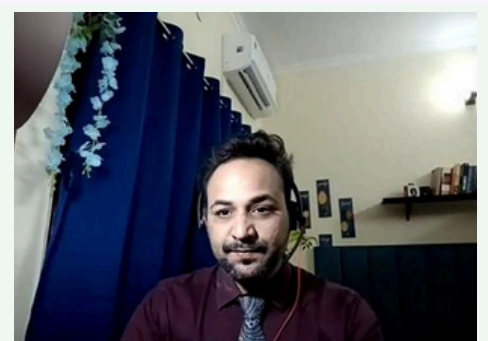
Annual General Body Meeting

ACP INDIA CHAPTER AWARDED AS ACP CHAPTER EXCELLENCE GOLD AWARD

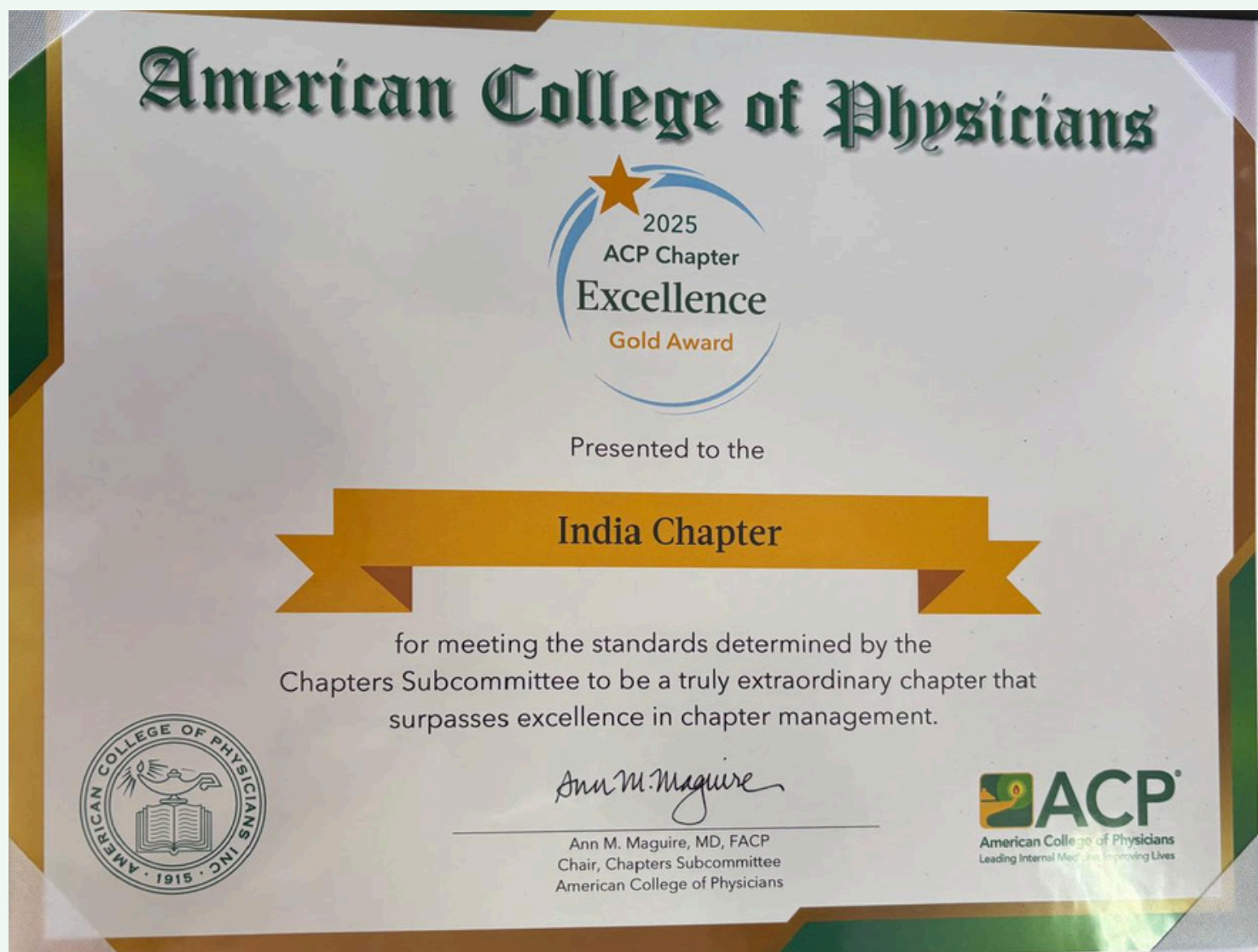
We are proud to announce that the ACP India Chapter has been awarded the prestigious ACP Chapter Excellence Gold Award for 2025.

Together, we continue our journey of excellence in internal medicine, education, and patient care.

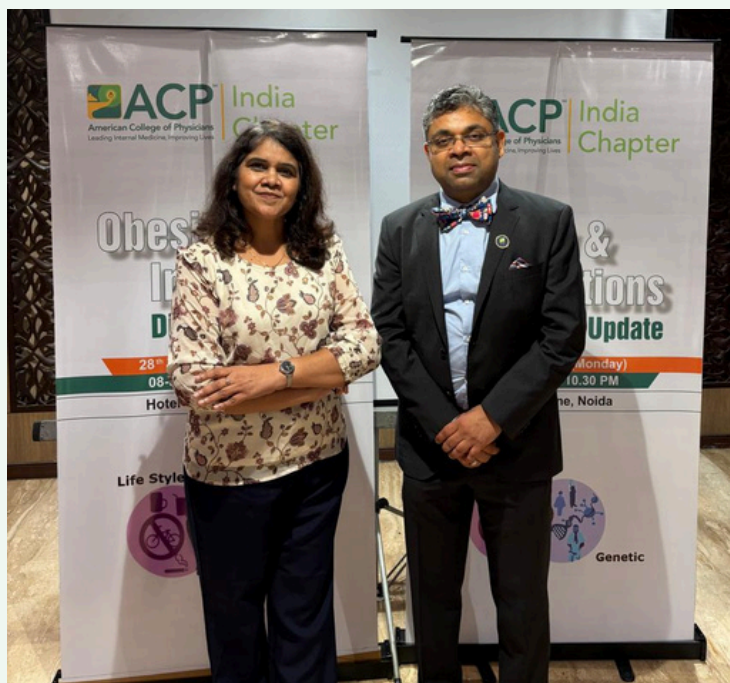


Obesity and Infectious Disease Update in Collaboration with ACP, 28th July 2025, Delhi

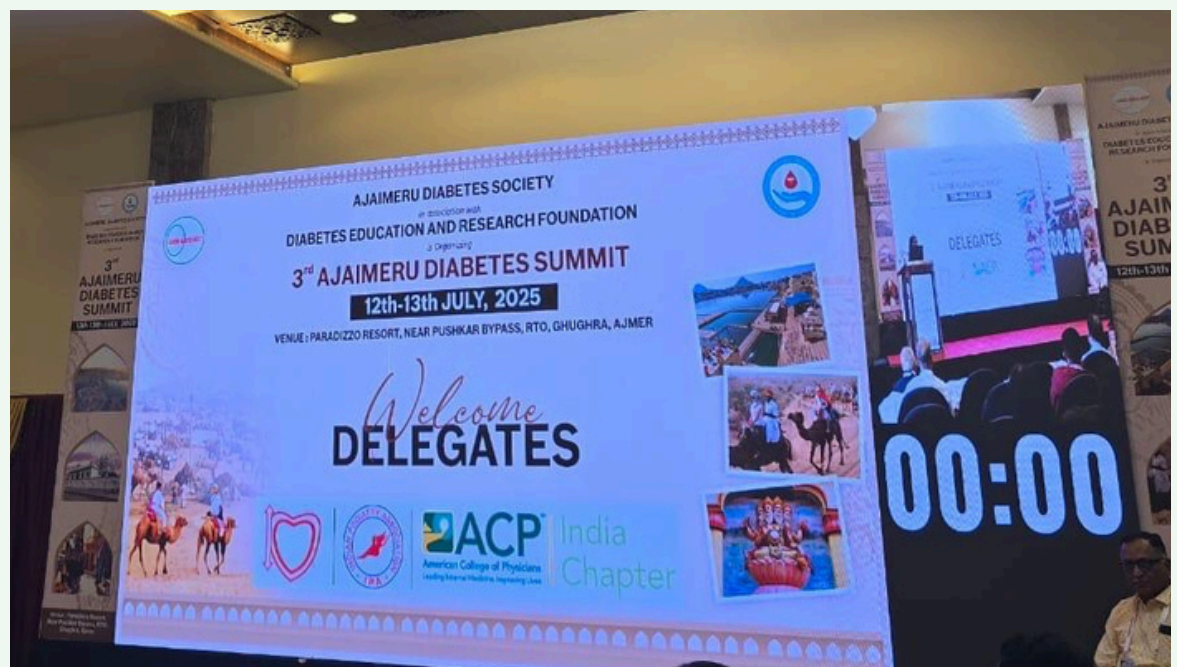
