PROJECT IRIS

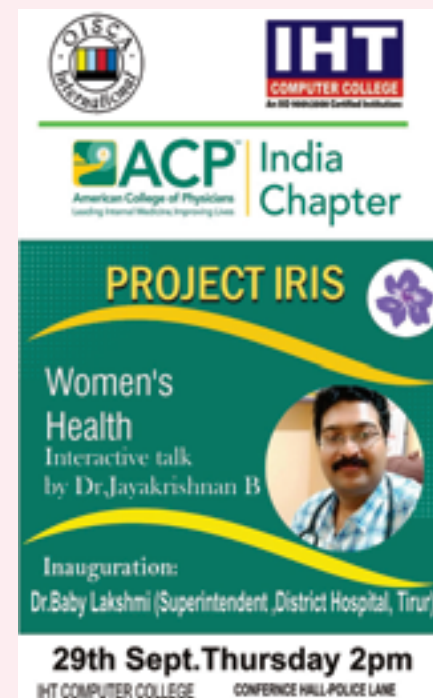
