

2019 Legislative Priorities

- Continue advocacy for a Georgia Waiver that provides an increase in Medicaid coverage
 - -Leverage state funds to draw increased federal funding to increase access to care
- 2. Monitor legislation to assure patients have access to safe, patient-centered, high-quality care. Advocate against allowing APRNs to practice independently without physician supervision
- 3. Support legislation to address the opioid crisis in Georgia without imposing additional administrative burdens or costs to physician practices
- 4. Support legislation to assure patient protections in out of network billing without imposing additional administrative burdens to physicians or their practices
- 5. Support legislation to promote increased physician loan forgiveness and PTIP bill from a tax deduction to a tax credit for community faculty
- 6. Support legislation to provide improved infrastructure for access in rural communities to telemedicine
- 7. Support legislation to reduce the administrative burdens of Prior authorizations
