- 2. Oral vignettes are limited to <u>five minutes</u> in length. Oral vignettes will be presented during ACP Residents' and Medical Students' Day, Wednesday, November 4, 2020.
- 2. Slide presentations MUST be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to <a href="mailto:linearth: linearth: linea
- 3. <u>Oral vignette presentations will be judged on</u>: Case Selection, Content (introduction, description of case, literature review, discussion, and summary), Presentation (organization, audiovisual aids, question answering, within time frame) and Overall Impact.

POSTER COMPETITION

- 1. Poster entries from **Medical Student and Residents** in the following categories will be accepted: Clinical Vignette, Research, Patient Safety/QI and High Value Care.
- 2. Patient Safety/QI and High Value Care will be judged within the same category.
- 3. Abstracts are due on <u>August 12, 2020</u>. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission form on the Chapter website. Abstracts are limited to 450 words not including title or authors.
- 4. A total of 100 abstracts will be selected for poster competition. All other abstracts meeting standards will be accepted as E-Posters.
- 5. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
- 6. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Oral Clinical Vignette competition.
- 7. The poster competition will be limited, and selection will be made by the Illinois ACP to assure that there are a variety of types of posters (research vs. clinical vignette), subspecialty representation, and program representation.

 A person may be first author on only ONE poster. You will be notified via email by September 11, 2020 if your poster is accepted.
- 8. Posters must be on display no later than 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, November 4, 2020. Poster judging will take place on Wednesday, November 4, 2020. First authors are expected to be present by their poster for their entire judging period. Failure to be present for judging will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- 9. E-Posters MUST be submitted in PDF format to lLNPosters@gmail.com NO LATER than Wednesday, September 30, 2020. E-Posters are NOT judged, and will be on display throughout the day on Wednesday, November 4, 2020.
- 10. Posters specifications (size, print, etc.) will be sent to competitors when accepted poster emails are sent by September 11, 2020.
- 11. Posters will be judged on the following: Originality, Significance, Presentation, Methods (if applicable), Visual Impact, and Interview.

- 5. ACP ILN can accept up to 16 Teams. Once 16 Teams have been accepted the competition is full.
- 6. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
- 7. Participants may not enter both the Oral Clinical Vignette competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
- 8. Each team will consist of 3 residents. Team members can come from any resident year.
- 9. The preliminary sessions, semi-finals, and finals will be open to an audience and will be held in the on Wednesday, November 4, 2020.
- 10. Award presentations will be **Wednesday evening**, November 4, 2020, before the Doctor's Dilemma final competition. All competitors are expected to attend the awards portion of the meeting.
