INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION ACP NORTHERN ILLINOIS RESIDENTS' AND MEDICAL STUDENTS' DAY

ORAL CLINICAL VIGNETTE COMPETITION

- 1. <u>One</u> resident and <u>one</u> medical student from each of the Northern Illinois Internal Medicine residency programs/medical schools will be selected by their program to submit an oral clinical vignette abstract.
- 1. Each program/medical school must send participant's name, email, and abstract BY September 5, 2025 at 11:59pm. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted. Submit to this Link
- 2. Abstracts with be prejudged and the top 6-8 (depending on time allotment will be accepted to in-person presentation.
- 3. Oral vignettes are limited to <u>five minutes</u> in length. Oral vignettes will be presented live on November 12th, 2025.
- 2. Slide presentations MUST be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to <u>Submit to this Link</u> by the date sent by ACP ILN.
- 4. <u>Oral vignette presentations will be judged on</u>: Case Selection, Content (introduction, description of case, literature review, discussion, and summary), Presentation (organization, audiovisual aids, question answering, within time frame) and Overall Impact.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION ACP NORTHERN ILLINOIS RESIDENTS' AND MEDICAL STUDENTS' DAY

POSTER COMPETITION

- 1. The first author of the abstract MUST be an ACP Member to submit.
- 2. Poster entries from Medical Student and Residents in the following categories will be accepted: Clinical Vignette, Research, Quality Improvement, Cost-Conscious and High Value Care. *Quality Improvement, Cost-conscious Care, and High Value Care will be judged within the same category.
- 3. Abstracts are due on August 3, 2025 at 11:59pm at 11:59pm. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission form on the Chapter website. Abstracts are limited to 450 words not including title or authors. No need to include citations in the abstract.
- 4. The poster competition will be limited, and selection will be made by the Illinois ACP to assure that there are a variety of types of posters (research vs. clinical vignette), subspecialty representation, and program representation.

 A person may be first author on only ONE poster.
- 5. No media link is needed for the abstract competition. Media Links (for recorded presentation) and more information will be provided if your abstract is accepted.
- 6. Posters will be judged on the following: Originality, Significance, Presentation, Methods (if applicable), Visual Impact, and Interview.

- 8. Original abstracts that either have or have not been presented at other meetings (including ACP chapters/Regions) will be considered. Abstracts previously submitted to the National Meeting are not eligible and are subject to disqualification.
- 9. Presentation of original work at the ACP meeting may, however, jeopardize presentation before another society. Abstracts are eligible if they have been published; however, the resident should notify the journal that the material is being presented at the ACP Chapter meeting.

- 3. ACP ILN can accept up to 16 Teams. Once 16 Teams have been accepted the competition is full.
- 4. Each team will consist of 3 residents. Team members can come from any resident year.
- 5. The preliminary sessions and semi-finals will all be virtual in September 15th with times TBD. The Final Session will be in person in November 12th, 2025.
