ORAL CLINICAL VIGNETTE COMPETITION

- 1. <u>One</u> resident and <u>one</u> medical student from each of the Northern Illinois Internal Medicine residency programs/medical schools will be selected by their program to present an **oral clinical vignette**. A separate competition will be held for medical students with the same rules as below.
- 2. Oral Vignette abstract forms are due on <u>July 29, 2015.</u> NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted. Abstracts must be prepared as directed and submitted via the online abstract submission form on the chapter website. Abstracts may not exceed 450 words.
- 3. Oral vignettes are limited to <u>five minutes</u> in length. Oral vignettes will be presented during ACP Residents' and Medical Students' Day, Wednesday, October 21, 2015.
- 4. Slide presentations MUST be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to IL.associates.day@gmail.com NO LATER than Wednesday, October 7, 2015.
- 5. <u>Oral vignette presentations will be judged on</u>: Case Selection, Content (introduction, description of case, literature review, discussion, and summary), Presentation (organization, audiovisual aids, question answering, within time frame) and Overall Impact.

POSTER COMPETITION

- 1. Poster entries in the following categories will be accepted: Clinical Vignette, Research, Patient Safety/QI, and High Value Care.
- 2. Abstracts are due on <u>July 29, 2015</u>. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission form on the Chapter website. Abstracts are limited to 450 words not including title or authors.
- 3. A total of 100 abstracts will be selected for poster competition. All other abstracts meeting standards will be accepted as E-Posters.
- 4. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
- 5. The poster competition will be limited, and selection will be made by the Illinois ACP to assure that there are a variety of types of posters (research vs. clinical vignette), subspecialty representation, and program representation.
 A person may be first author on only ONE poster. You will be notified via email by Wednesday, September 2, 2015 if your poster is accepted.
- 6. Posters must be on display no later than 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, October 21, 2015. Poster judging will take place in from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, October 21, 2015. **First authors are expected to be present by their poster for their entire judging period**. Failure to be present for judging will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- 7. E-Posters MUST be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to <u>LLassociates.day@gmail.com</u> NO LATER than Wednesday, September 30, 2015. E-Posters will be on display throughout the day on Friday, October 21, 2015.
- 8. Posters may be 42" wide x 36" tall <u>maximum</u>. Posters larger than 42" x 36" will not be accepted and will be automatically disqualified from the competition. Materials to hang posters will be available at the display area.
- 9. A single, lightweight poster is recommended for ease in displaying, however, the format is up to the presenter. The print on the posters should be large enough to be readable from 3 feet. Templates are available at www.makesigns.com/SciPosters Templates.aspx
- 10. Posters will be judged on the following: Originality, Significance, Presentation, Methods (if applicable), Visual Impact, and Interview.
