**ORAL CLINICAL VIGNETTE COMPETITION**

1. **One** resident and **one** medical student from each of the Northern Illinois Internal Medicine residency programs/medical schools will be selected by their program to present an **oral clinical vignette**. A separate competition will be held for medical students with the same rules as below.
2. Oral Vignette abstract forms are due on **August 17, 2016**. **NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted**. Abstracts must be prepared as directed and submitted via the online abstract submission form on the chapter website. Abstracts may not exceed 450 words.
3. **Oral vignettes are limited to five minutes in length**. Oral vignettes will be presented during ACP Residents' and Medical Students' Day, Wednesday, November 9, 2016.
4. Slide presentations **MUST** be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to [IL.associates.day@gmail.com](mailto:IL.associates.day@gmail.com) **NO LATER than Wednesday, October 26, 2016**.
5. Oral vignette presentations will be judged on: Case Selection, Content (introduction, description of case, literature review, discussion, and summary), Presentation (organization, audiovisual aids, question answering, within time frame) and Overall Impact.

**POSTER COMPETITION**

1. Poster entries in the following categories will be accepted: Clinical Vignette, Research, Patient Safety/QI, and High Value Care.
2. Abstracts are due on **August 17, 2016**. **NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted**. Abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission form on the Chapter website. Abstracts are limited to 450 words not including title or authors.
3. A total of 100 abstracts will be selected for poster competition. All other abstracts meeting standards will be accepted as E-Posters.
4. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
5. The poster competition will be limited, and selection will be made by the Illinois ACP to assure that there are a variety of types of posters (research vs. clinical vignette), subspecialty representation, and program representation. **A person may be first author on only ONE poster**. You will be notified via email by Wednesday, September 28, 2016 if your poster is accepted.
6. Posters must be on display no later than 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2016. Poster judging will take place on Wednesday, November 9, 2016. **First authors are expected to be present by their poster for their entire judging period**. Failure to be present for judging will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
7. E-Posters **MUST** be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to [IL.associates.day@gmail.com](mailto:IL.associates.day@gmail.com) **NO LATER than Wednesday, October 19, 2016**. E-Posters will be on display throughout the day on Wednesday, November 9, 2016.
8. Posters may be 42" wide x 36" tall **maximum**. **Posters larger than 42" x 36" will not be accepted and will be automatically disqualified from the competition**. Materials to hang posters will be available at the display area.
9. A single, lightweight poster is recommended for ease in displaying, however, the format is up to the presenter. The print on the posters should be large enough to be readable from 3 feet. 10. Posters will be judged on the following: Originality, Significance, Presentation, Methods (if applicable), Visual Impact, and Interview.
