

2026 Mississippi Chapter ACP Abstract Day

On Thursday, October 29, 2026, we will host the 31th Mississippi Chapter American College of Physicians (ACP) Abstract Day. The event will be held in person at the Norman C. Nelson Student Union in Jackson, Mississippi. Poster presentations will take place in the morning between 9:15 AM and 11:30 AM, followed by oral presentations during lunch from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM.

All students, residents, and subspecialty fellows enrolled in an accredited medical school, internal medicine residency, or subspecialty training program in Mississippi are eligible to submit their work. We will accept abstracts in the following four categories:

- Clinical Vignettes
- Clinical Research
- Basic Science Research
- Quality Improvement and Patient Safety

Faculty and fellow judges will evaluate abstracts prior to the competition and will assess presentations during the event to determine the winners.

We will be using the ACP Abstract Portal to collect submissions. The portal will remain open until Sunday, September 20, 2026, at 11:59 PM CDT.

Abstracts must be no longer than 500 words, excluding the title, authors, and author affiliations. Please do not include tables, graphs, figures, pictures, or references. The content of your abstract must pertain to internal medicine. If your submission is deemed not relevant to internal medicine, you will be notified within one week of the portal closing.

Submitting authors will receive an email regarding the judges' decision on acceptance and presentation type (oral or poster) on or before Sunday, October 4, 2026.
