What is the Flag Program?

Each day, a brightly colored flag is raised that corresponds with the local Air Quality Index (AQI) to inform the community about outdoor air quality conditions and if it is safe to play outside.

What is the Purpose of the Flag Program?

The Flag Program creates public awareness of air quality conditions. Unhealthy air can pose health threats including decreased lung function and worsening of respiratory illness such as asthma.
