





## \*Commercial members. 12 Month date range (7/1/18 – 6/30/19)

9.6% of members filled an opioid in the last year


Acute use: CDC Guidelines recommend treatment with opioids for 3 days or less will often be sufficient. >7 days is rarely needed.

200mg is frequently used within various guidelines as the highest threshold of opioid overdose risk

The CDC recommends caution when doses exceed 50mg MED and careful justification when dosing above 90mg MED

# 2019 Legislation

- HB86 (Ricci, R-Billings)
  - 7-day supply limit
  - Requires providers to check Rx Drug Registry
  - Photo ID for pickup
- SB61 (McDonald, D-Billings)
  - Requires all licensed providers to use Rx Drug Registry
- HB137 (Dudik, D-Missoula)
  - Establishes annual MT Rx drug take-back day
- SB30 (Gross, D-Billings)
  - Allows for Medicaid coverage of mental health peer support
- HB654 (Brown, D-Bozeman)
  - Creates \$500 licensing fee on wholesalers to expand mental health and drug treatment courts
- HB103 (Pierson, D-Deer Lodge)
  - Expands types of providers to diagnose chemical dependency


