Captain Alden Chiu, a native of Seal Beach, California, commissioned through the Health Professionals Scholarship Program in 2001. CAPT Chiu graduated summa cum laude from the University of Southern California with a bachelor of the arts in history. He obtained his medical degree from Cornell University and a master's in public health from the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. CAPT Chiu completed his internal medicine residency at the Naval Medical Center San Diego and his fellowship in hematology and medical oncology at the National Capital Consortium in Bethesda, Maryland.

Assigned to the 3rd Marine Logistics Group, CAPT Chiu was the Battalion Surgeon for 9th Engineering Support Battalion in Okinawa. CAPT Chiu completed a tour as staff oncologist at Naval Medical Center San Diego. For Pacific Partnership 2015, CAPT Chiu served as Associate Director for Medical Operations for the Medical Treatment Facility USNS Mercy (T-AH 19) and led planning for missions in Fiji and the Philippines. From 2016 to 2022, CAPT Chiu was assigned to Walter Reed National Military Medical Center where he was appointed Chief of the Hematology/Oncology Service and Deputy Director for the John P. Murtha Cancer Center. CAPT Chiu held positions as Medical Director for the Hematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation Program, Chair of the Healthcare Ethics Committee, Consultant to the White House Medical Unit, and Product Line Chair for Hematology/Oncology in the NCR Market. He completed his term as Assistant Specialty Leader for Hematology/Oncology to the Surgeon General and Bureau of Medicine in 2023. CAPT Chiu assumed charge of Fleet Surgical Team SEVEN in 2022 and served as CATF Surgeon for the USS America (LHA-6) Amphibious Ready Group. In that role, he simultaneously served as the Assistant Chief of Staff for Medical for Commander Expeditionary Strike Group SEVEN and Amphibious Forces SEVENTH Fleet. His current assignment is as Force Surgeon for Commander Naval Surface Force Atlantic.



CAPT Chiu is a diplomat of the American Board of Internal Medicine with board certifications in Internal Medicine, Hematology, and Medical Oncology. He is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences and a Fellow of the American College of Physicians. He is the recipient of a Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, two Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals and three Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals.
