Faculty and subspecialty fellows are encouraged to work with residents and students on their abstract and poster but will not be able to be listed as the first author or present posters. Each medical student or resident may submit *one* **abstract as first author**. No exceptions to this will be made.

Abstracts will be accepted into one of *five* categories: Clinical Vignette, Clinical Research, Basic Research, Quality Improvement/Patient Safety, or High Value Cost Conscious Care. These five categories are identical to those in the ACP National Abstract Competition.
