## **ACP Tennessee Chapter 2020 Abstract Competition**

- 1. Resident and student poster presentations may be either clinical vignettes or research projects, including quality improvement. Resident poster presenters qualify to present for the oral competition, if selected by your program director to do so.
- 2. Prior to submission all abstracts need to be approved by the program/institution designated individual. No abstract will be accepted outside of the programs chosen presenters.
- 3. All abstracts must be submitted by August 15, 2020.
- 4. All presenters must be ACP members.
- 5. All presenters MUST be registered for the meeting by August 15<sup>th</sup>. Registration is free, and details about registration will be provided on the <u>chapter web site</u> when available.

Accepted abstracts should then be prepared for poster presentation. Posters must be 36" width by 24" height (landscape orientation). ANYTHING BIGGER WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. More specific information on preparing a poster can be found on the chapter website. Presenters will be required to register for the conference (CONFERENCE REGISTERATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY AUGUST 15<sup>TH</sup>), display posters from Friday morning 10/23 through 10/24 at noon, and attend the entire conference.

The TN Chapter will send up to two top scoring resident winners to the ACP National IM meeting. In order for two winners to qualify to go to the IM meeting their abstract submissions must be in different categories.
