The Future of MOC (Continuing Certification) The Continuing Board Certification: Vision for the Future Commission, established by the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), released its draft report for public comment on December 11, 2018. visioninitiative.org/commission/draft-report The report includes the Commission's key findings and recommendations, and is open for public comment until Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at 11:00 p.m. CST. Feedback collected during the public comment period will help shape the Commission's final report and recommendations on future continuing certification (maintenance of certification) programs. The final report will be submitted to the ABMS Board of Directors in February 2019. ACP members are encouraged to submit comments. ACP will continue to advocate for programs that reflect our Principles of Accountability and that meet the needs of ACP members and their patients
