## Identifying Core Clinical Topic Areas in Internal Medicine

**Aim:** Identify a set of clinical topics that are of core importance to internal medicine.

**Purpose:** Adopt a unified, strategic approach within the Division of Clinical Policy by developing and maintaining a portfolio of clinical policies on topics fundamental to internal medicine. The Clinical Guidelines Committee and Performance Measurement Committee will use the list to inform topic selection, considering it alongside existing topic selection criteria when prioritizing topics for policy development.

**Process:**

1. Form a subgroup of committee leadership from Clinical Guidelines Committee (CGC), Performance Measurement Committee (PMC), and Scientific Medical Policy Committee (SMPC) to lead the core clinical topics project (*Completed March 2022*).
2. Devise and use a data driven approach to identify core clinical topic areas in internal medicine.
  - Work with the subgroup to approve data sources for identifying potential core clinical topics (*Completed August 2022*).
  - CGC, PMC, and SMPC review, suggest additional data sources, and approve final list of data sources (see Table 1) (*Completed September 2022*). Data sources were categorized into four domains – member needs, quality, resource utilization, and equity. **See Table 1.**
3. After committee approval, share with senior officers for review and comment (*Completed September 2022*).
4. After senior officers' review, share data sources with ECBOR for review and comment (*Completed December 2022*).
  - After the initial list from the various sources has been identified, subgroup to guide staff in responding to questions and refining the list further, if needed.
5. Cross-reference data sources to identify common clinical conditions (*Completed December 2022*).
6. Subgroup review the list and approve a list of core clinical topics (*Completed January 2023*).
7. CGC and PMC review list for final approval (*In progress, January-February 2023*). **See Table 2.**
8. Public Panel, BOR and BOG review and comment on list (*March 2023*).
9. Present final list to BOR for information (*April 2023*).
