

### **End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)**

**How Developed:** The nephrology workgroup focused on identifying and refining existing tools related to ESRD -- for patients transitioning to both dialysis (including hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis, and home hemodialysis) and transplantation. The workgroup included both adult and pediatric nephrologists and patient representatives. The following members of the nephrology workgroup support the policy statement found in Transition from Pediatric to Adult Renal Services: a <u>Consensus Statement</u> by the International Society of Nephrology (ISN) and the International Pediatric Nephrology Association (IPNA) (KI (2011) 80, 704-707): RPA, AAKP, ASPN, and the Forum. The statement identifies five points to ensure quality care. The statement also suggests procedures for implementing the policies.

This 10domain, 32-item questionnaire is administered (in person or by phone) by a trained professional in about 7-8 minutes. Each response is scored individually as either 1 (adequate knowledge/skill mastery), 0.5 (some knowledge/skill attainment), and 0 (no knowledge/skill attainment) for a maximum score of 10.

Read the question to the parent, and circle the choice on the right that best describes the parent's response. Sum the scores for each section in the "Subtotal" row. Not all questions may be applicable to each parent.

Divide the subtotal by the number of applicable questions in each section to obtain the "Proportion."
