

## Clinical Vignette & Research Poster Competition Guidelines

### Medical Student, Resident/Fellow, & Early Career Physician Members

Participants must set up their poster in the Medical Student – Resident/Fellow - Early Career Physician Poster Area, located in Hall G of the Los Angeles Convention Center. Each presenter has been assigned a specific poster board number. You will be sent an email with a link to check-in a few hours before your assigned poster session. This check-in process will generate the board number and display this information. Please see staff in the adjacent Hospitality Area for presenter ribbons.

**Each presenter will be asked to give a 4 minute “presentation overview” of their work, leaving 6 minutes for a question and answer session with the judges.** Medical Student and Resident/Fellow Winners will be announced at the Young Achievers Recognition Reception on Saturday evening. Winners from the Early Career Physician Poster Competition will be announced Thursday afternoon. Results will also be posted on the website the week following the Internal Medicine Meeting 2020.

Each presenter will be allocated a space of 4 feet wide by 4 feet in length. Presenters will be required to adhere to these limits. No exceptions can be made. ***It is suggested that the final poster size be slightly smaller than the allocated board dimensions - 3 ½ feet wide by 3 ½ feet in length.*** It has a cork base, with a fabric covering. Push-pins will be available on-site. You are asked to make no major alterations in the text of your abstract. This is strictly a poster competition. Therefore, laptops with slide shows are not permitted as part of your presentation.

#### ePoster

In addition to the paper poster, all participants will be required to create an ePoster so that all posters can be viewed throughout the entire meeting. The ePoster will consist of 1 slide formatted as a poster and can be easily made using Microsoft PowerPoint. Please log in to the abstract system and upload your ePoster no later than **February 28, 2020**.
