ACP's Work With CMS

ACP has ongoing conversations with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and saw historic wins reflected in the final 2020 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule, including:

- Reversed the decision to pay a flat fee for office visits; instead, pay will be based on complexity
- Increased payment for all office visit codes
- Decreased documentation requirement for office visits
- Implemented payments for care coordination and prolonged services
- Increased the accessibility and interoperability of digital health information

Additionally, ACP works closely with CMS on the Quality Payment Program and provides recommendations geared to reduce clinician burden, enhance performance measurement, and strengthen the patient-physician relationship.



Payment Options

Physicians can choose from one of two payment tracks to avoid penalties and earn potential increases in Medicare payments.

MIPS (Merit-Based Incentive Payment System) is based on a weighted composite performance score made up of Quality, Promoting Interoperability (PI), Improvement Activities (IA), and Cost.



APMs (Alternative Payment Models) include certain programs that incentivize quality and value and include Medicare Shared Savings Programs, Primary Care First, Direct Contracting Model, Accountable Care Organizations, and CMS Innovation Center models that are not part of Health Care Innovation Awards.


