

Clinical Vignette & Research Poster Competition Guidelines
Medical Student, Resident/Fellow, & Early Career Physician Members

Participants must set up their poster in the Career and Professional Development Center, located in Hall AB of the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center. Each presenter has been assigned a specific poster board number. You will be sent an email with a link to check-in a few hours before your assigned poster session. This check-in process will generate the board number and display this information. Please see staff in the adjacent Hospitality Area for presenter ribbons.

Each presenter will be asked to give a 4 minute “presentation overview” of their work, leaving 6 minutes for a question-and-answer session with the judges. All winners will be announced at the Celebrating Internal Medicine Reception on Saturday evening. Results will also be posted on the website the week following the Internal Medicine Meeting 2024.

Each presenter will be allocated a space of 4 feet wide by 4 feet in length. Presenters will be required to adhere to these limits. No exceptions can be made. ***It is suggested that the final poster size be slightly smaller than the allocated board dimensions - 3 ½ feet wide by 3 ½ feet in length.*** It has a cork base, with a fabric covering. Pushpins will be available on-site. You are asked to make no major alterations in the text of your abstract. This is strictly a poster competition. Therefore, laptops with slide shows are not permitted as part of your presentation.

There is a 1 slide limit for the ePoster and the final file should not exceed 100 MB along with a 4-minute time limit.
