Research suggests that great leaders are great negotiators. They resolve seemingly intractable disputes and yet enhance working relationships. The ability to negotiate requires a collection of interpersonal and communication skills used together to bring a desired result. A person's negotiation and communication skills determine his/her effectiveness. This session provides tools for identifying individual communication preferences, delivery methods, conflict resolution styles as well identifying best practices and alternative to a negotiated agreement (BATNA). The session is interactive and involves exercises and activities that allow the participants to practice the new skills.
