1. **One** resident and **one** medical student from each of the Northern Illinois Internal Medicine residency programs/medical schools will be selected **by their program** to present an **oral clinical vignette**.
2. Each program/medical school must send participant's name, email, and abstract **BY 10:59pm on August 21, 2019 to IL.associates.day@gmail.com** **NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted.**
3. **Oral vignettes are limited to five minutes in length.** Oral vignettes will be presented during ACP Residents' and Medical Students' Day, Wednesday, October 23, 2019.
4. Slide presentations **MUST** be submitted in Microsoft PowerPoint format to IL.associates.day@gmail.com **NO LATER than Wednesday, October 2, 2019.**
5. **Oral vignette presentations will be judged on:** Case Selection, Content (introduction, description of case, literature review, discussion, and summary), Presentation (organization, audiovisual aids, question answering, within time frame) and Overall Impact.

POSTER COMPETITION

1. Poster entries in the following categories will be accepted: Clinical Vignette, Research, Patient Safety/QI and High Value Care.
2. Patient Safety/QI and High Value Care will be judged within the same category.
3. Abstracts are due on **August 4, 2019**. **NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted**. Abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission form on the Chapter website. Abstracts are limited to 450 words not including title or authors.
4. A total of 100 abstracts will be selected for poster competition. All other abstracts meeting standards will be accepted as E-Posters.
5. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
6. The poster competition will be limited, and selection will be made by the Illinois ACP to assure that there are a variety of types of posters (research vs. clinical vignette), subspecialty representation, and program representation. **A person may be first author on only ONE poster**. You will be notified via email by August 30, 2019 if your poster is accepted.
7. Posters must be on display no later than 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, October 23, 2019. Poster judging will take place on Wednesday, October 23, 2019. **First authors are expected to be present by their poster for their entire judging period**. Failure to be present for judging will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
8. E-Posters **MUST** be submitted in PDF format to IL.associates.day@gmail.com **NO LATER than Wednesday, September 25, 2019**. E-Posters will be on display throughout the day on Wednesday, October 23, 2019.
9. Posters specifications (size, print, etc.) will be sent to competitors when accepted poster emails are sent by August 30, 2019.
10. Posters will be judged on the following: Originality, Significance, Presentation, Methods (if applicable), Visual Impact, and Interview.

3. Participants may not enter both the Poster competition and the Doctor's Dilemma competition.
4. Each team will consist of one 1st year resident, one 2nd year resident, and one 3rd year resident.
5. The preliminary sessions, semi-finals, and finals will be open to an audience and will be held in the on Wednesday, October 23, 2019.
6. Award presentations will be **Wednesday evening**, October 23, 2019, before the Doctor's Dilemma final competition. All competitors are expected to attend the awards portion of the meeting.
