

***Become an ACP Quality Champion to Raise Adult Immunization Rates  
through the Promotion of Racial and Ethnic Equity in Primary Care!***

ACP's Center for Quality invites you to participate as a quality improvement (QI) champion in our initiative to increase adult immunization rates in primary care. The ACP Quality Connect: I Raise the Rates initiative provides you with the skills to lead practice transformation and QI efforts, resulting in real and meaningful change in adult immunization rates while promoting equity among racial and ethnic minority populations. The program utilizes a collaborative, data-driven approach to encourage patient-centered, team-based clinical care and to foster improved care processes and outcomes. The program offers specialized training in:

- Understanding barriers to immunizing adults in racial and ethnic minorities
- Getting your patients immunized, while realizing opportunities for increased revenue, patient engagement tools and training, and performance data reporting, including for Medicare
- Integrating use of ACP's patient tools in practice and treatment workflow

**Participating champions will receive:**

- A **\$1000** honorarium
- **Free** access to coaching calls with national QI experts, webinars, patient engagement materials
- **Free** access to ACP's platform on MedConcert, which allows you to submit data in a semi-automated fashion, assess your performance across up to 5 immunization measures (influenza, pneumococcal for high-risk patients under 65, pneumococcal for patients 65 and up, Tdap, and zoster), identify gaps in performance, and link to improvement tools.
- Eligibility for CME/CE and MOC

**Champions are requested to:**

- Attend the virtual training at a date to be announced.
- Implement two QI cycles at their practices using the plan-do-study-act (PDSA) model.
- Participate and encourage staff members to participate in two live or web-based educational programs hosted by the state chapter or national ACP
- Engage in two coaching calls with national experts
- Report performance measures and other data requirements (e.g., practice assessment and provider surveys)
