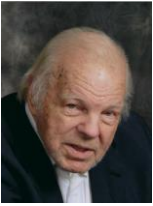


Laureate Award
Josephine Dhar, MD, FACP

Dr. Dhar has spent her career in academic medicine. She taught medical students, residents and rheumatology fellows-in-training for more than 20 years at Wayne State University School of Medicine (WSUSOM). During her time as a faculty member at WSUSOM, she created and served as the course director for the Connective Tissue/Dermatology Unit for second year medical students, as well as served as associate program director for the Internal Medicine residency program.

Dr. Dhar spent 4 years (2014-2018) helping to get the new medical school at Central Michigan University obtain LCME accreditation. During her tenure there, she served as Chief of Medicine, Program Director for Internal Medicine, Founding Course Director for the Musculoskeletal/Dermatology course for medical students, and Founding Clerkship Director for Internal Medicine core rotation for medical students, as well as served on multiple key committees for the school.

Her main research interests are HPV infection and cervical neoplasia in SLE as well as HPV vaccination in SLE, and she is a member of the Michigan Cancer Consortium HPV working group. She is currently at Ascension St. John Hospital where she is developing an Academic Rheumatology program. Dr. Dhar is dedicated to patient care and the education of medical students, residents and fellows.



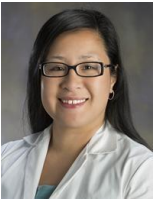
Laureate Award

Vernon Wendt, MD, FACP

Dr. Wendt received his medical degree from Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons in New York in 1956. He then completed a residency in internal medicine and cardiology fellowship at Wayne State University School of Medicine. He served as assistant professor of medicine at Wayne State University School of Medicine and Director of the Cardiac Cath Laboratory at the Detroit Receiving Hospital. He is currently Associate Clinical Professor of Medicine at Michigan State University College of Human Medicine. He has been an active staff member at Blodgett Memorial, Hutzel Hospital, Spectrum Health, Pine Rest Christian Hospital, Ferguson Hospital, Forest View Hospital, and St. Mary's Medical Center. He has contributed to the care of patients in the state of Michigan for over 50 years.

Dr. Wendt has been a member of over 18 professional societies including being a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, member of the Michigan Thoracic Society, and past President of the Michigan Society of Internal Medicine. He has received over 8 professional honors including being recognized by Who's Who in America and Who's Who in Medicine and Health Care and being a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology and the American College of Angiology. He has published 30 peer-reviewed articles in prestigious journals that include: Chest, Circulation, the American Journal of Medicine, the American Journal Physiology, Medicine Clinics of North America, Journal of the American Medical Association, the American Heart Journal, and the American Journal of Cardiology.

Noteworthy has been Dr. Wendt's abiding commitment to the Michigan Chapter of the American College of Physicians. He regularly attends our annual meeting and is an active participant on the Council for the Michigan Chapter of the American College of Physicians. Because of his sustained and exemplary performance over five decades to excellence in patient care, education, and research and in the service to his community and the Michigan Chapter, the American College of Physicians is pleased to present the Laureate Award to Dr. Wendt.



Raymond H. Murray Governor's Award

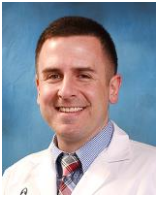
Aimee Espinosa, MD, FACP

Dr. Aimee Espinosa earned her undergraduate degree in Biology from Hillsdale College in 1999 and she went on to Thomas Jefferson University where she earned her Master's Degree in Microbiology and Immunology in 2003. Though bench research was enjoyable for her, she had a desire to pursue her education further and earned her MD degree at Wayne State University School of Medicine.

Dr. Espinosa completed her residency in Internal Medicine at William Beaumont Hospital and served as Chief Medical Resident. She joined the Primary Care faculty practice at Beaumont Health in Royal Oak and split her time to simultaneously work alongside her father in his rural Internal Medicine practice in Columbiaville, Michigan.

In 2014, Dr. Espinosa elected to concentrate her efforts on her primary care practice at Beaumont Health where she was selected to be an Associate Program Director for the Internal Medicine residency program. She continues to serve as core ambulatory faculty.

In addition to her work in graduate medical education, she has a special interest in faculty development. In the Spring 2014 she trained for a month at the Stanford Faculty Development Center. Since that time, she has been able to facilitate many faculty and resident groups in the Stanford Clinical Teaching Program and has held the position of Director of Faculty Development Scholars at the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine, Michigan where she is also an Assistant Professor in Internal Medicine.

Michael Kern, MD, FACP

Dr. Kern is a graduate of the American University of the Caribbean and completed internal medicine at Ascension St John Hospital. He has been a faculty member in internal medicine since 2016. He also is the ACLS simulation lab coordinator for the internal residency and the co leader for Ascension St John Faculty Development. He has completed the Stanford Faculty Development Clinical Teaching Facilitator training program.

He has been a member of the American College of Physicians for the last 7 years and was made an FACP in 2016. Dr. Kern has been active in the American College of Physicians at the local and national levels. He has served as the national ACP Academic Advisory Delegate and as the co-chair for the ACP Michigan Early Career Physician committee. He coordinated the Michigan ACP Early Career Physicians kickoff "Battling Burnout" in 2018. He has regularly served as an ACP Michigan Chapter judge for abstracts and presentations at meetings since 2016. Dr. Kern also has been the ACP Michigan Co-chair for Membership and Advancement and participated in meetings on Capitol Hill during ACP Leadership day.

He has been recognized for his contributions as a clinician by receiving the Ascension Pacesetter Award. Dr. Kern emulates the dedication of a physician, teacher, mentor and role model as an internal medicine physician. He has devoted many hours to the Michigan Chapter as well as our national organization. Because of his continued dedication and hard work for the ACP Michigan chapter, we are pleased to present the Raymond Murray Governor's award to him.



Volunteerism & Community Service Award

Hari Conjeevaram, MD, FACP

Dr. Hari Conjeevaram is Professor of Medicine in the Division of Gastroenterology at the University of Michigan. He is also the Program Director for GI Fellowship and the Medical Director of the UM Student Run Free Clinic. In addition to patient care, he has also been actively involved in medical research and in education and mentoring physicians in different countries both in the US and globally including India and Ethiopia. He has been active in global education of medical students, residents and fellows in Gastroenterology and has been instrumental in mediating collaborative partnerships with global institutions. Additionally, he has been able to coordinate several medical service activities both here in the US and across the globe and motivate and inspire others to render their time to volunteer for these efforts.

Dr. Conjeevaram has won numerous awards for his teaching and for his community service activities, some of which include “University of Michigan Dean’s Award for Community Service”, “Shining Hero Award” for outstanding service, and the “Leonard Tow Humanism in Medicine Award”. In 2017 he was inducted into the University of Michigan Clinical Excellence Society “Academiae Laureati Medici” and he was the recipient of the 2017 TANA (Telugu Association of North America) Award for “Excellence in the Field of Medicine and Community Service” and also the 2017 American Gastroenterological Association Distinguished “Lifetime Educator Award” that is presented to an individual for achievements as an outstanding educator over a lifelong career.



Great Internist of Michigan Award

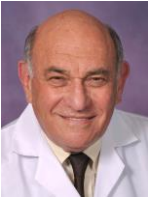
John (Jack) Billi, MD, FACP

Dr. Billi serves as Professor in Internal Medicine and Learning Health Sciences, Health Management and Policy, and Integrated Systems and Design at the University of Michigan. Dr. Billi's interests are in health services delivery, especially the use of lean thinking to improve quality and efficiency, the use of community collaboratives to improve quality and population health, clinical practice transformation tied to value-based reimbursement, the creation and use of evidence-based guidelines, and conflict of interest management.

Dr. Billi has led the Michigan Quality System, the University of Michigan Health System's (UMHS) business strategy to help transform clinical operations through deployment of scientific problem solving and coaching. The goal of MQS is to improve safety, quality, timeliness, financial stewardship, and people engagement in healthcare delivery through problem solving by every worker and leader.

Dr. Billi is active in statewide, regional and national initiatives to improve quality and efficiency of care. UMHS serves as the coordinating center for 16 statewide Collaborative Quality Initiatives funded by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan.

Dr. Billi has contributed to American Heart Association emergency cardiac care committees and the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation. Dr. Billi's management roles at UM have included Associate Vice President for Medical Affairs, Associate Dean of the Medical School, and the Medical School's liaison officer to the Ann Arbor VA Health System. Dr. Billi practices as a general internist in a primary care clinic at the University of Michigan.



Lifetime Achievement Award

Jack Sobel, MD, MACP

Dr. Sobel is Dean of the School of Medicine at Wayne State University, previously Chair of Internal Medicine and Chief of the Division of Infectious Diseases and Distinguished Professor of Medicine at Wayne State University School of Medicine. A graduate of the University of Witwatersrand, Johannesburg, South Africa, Dr. Sobel did his fellowship in Infectious Diseases at the National Institute of Health and the Medical College of Pennsylvania. He is a board certified internal medicine specialist in the United States, the United Kingdom, Israel and South Africa and became a Master in the American College of Physicians in 2013.

He has specialized in *Candida* infections of the genitourinary tract. His research has encompassed microbiology, immunology and molecular biology of *Candida* infections.

After more than a decade of studying systemic candidiasis, Dr. Sobel chose to limit his mycology interest to clinical vulvovaginal candidiasis. He was the first to report multi-drug resistant vaginitis due to a variety of *Candida* species as well as developing new treatment protocols. His focus on these infections has contributed to progress in unravelling the genetic basis for these infections. Over the last decade, he has turned his attention to other vaginal inflammatory conditions, notably recurrent and refractory bacterial vaginosis and immune mediated auto-inflammatory vaginitis focusing on the role of the vaginal microbiome. His ground-breaking treatments are the standard of care throughout the world.

He is the author of more than 500 manuscripts and more than 150 book chapters. While Chief of Infectious Diseases at Wayne, more than 70 ID fellows graduated as specialists. In the eyes of these graduates, Dr. Sobel is known for encouraging medical curiosity in his graduates to be known as the “Why?” doctors.

Serving as Dean for the last 5 years has not diminished his passion or commitment to infectious diseases and the task of educating medical students.



Michigan Hospitalist of the Year Award David Vandenberg, MD, SFHM

Dr. Vandenberg completed his undergraduate studies at Oakland University. He graduated from Wayne State University School of Medicine, and completed his Residency in Internal Medicine at WSU Affiliated Hospitals (Detroit Medical Center).

Dr. Vandenberg has practiced Hospital Medicine his entire 29-year career, beginning as the Associate Director of the Hospital-based Physician Program at Harper Hospital. He designed and directed the first Hospitalist-run Observation unit in Michigan. He was instrumental in integrating Advanced Practice Professionals into hospital-based care models. Dr. Vandenberg has served as faculty and advisor for multiple Wayne State's and Eastern Michigan University's Physician Assistant Schools.

Dr. Vandenberg co-founded one of the largest hospitalist groups in the state. He served as the Medical Director of Select Specialty Hospital-Ann Arbor for 8 years. For the past 20 years, he has practiced at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital-Ann Arbor. He has served as the Medical Director of Utilization and Care Management and Medical Director of the St Joes' employed Hospitalist Program. Dr. Vandenberg was instrumental in coordinating the care of the nearly 600 patients affected by the 2012 Fungal Meningitis Outbreak, caused by contaminated paraspinal steroid injections. He was recently named Vice President and Chief Medical Officer for St Joseph Mercy Ann Arbor and Livingston Hospitals.

Dr. Vandenberg was a founding member of the National Association of Inpatient Physicians and participated in the formation of the Michigan Hospital Medicine Safety Collaborative. A recipient of numerous clinical and teaching awards, he was awarded the designation of SHM Senior Fellow in 2011.
