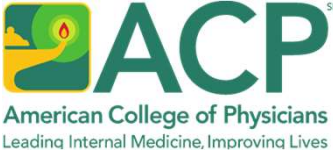

E/M Documentation Changes 2021

- History and Exam would no longer be used for code selection; but are performed and documented as clinically appropriate.
- Medical Decision Making (MDM) *or* total time on the date of the encounter may be used for code selection (without regard to whether counseling and coordination of care dominate the service)
- RVU reimbursement decrease by 11%
