



New Mexico ACP Chapter Medical Student Award

Recipients of the New Mexico ACP Chapter Medical Student Award must demonstrate dedication and contributions in the field of Internal Medicine through scholarship, education, research and/or community service. First through fourth year medical students are eligible. Recipients must also be members in our local ACP chapter.

Nominations may be submitted by peers, resident physicians, faculty advisors, or physician mentors who recognize the significance of the nominee's work. Self nominations will not be accepted. Multiple nominators can support an individual's nomination. Nomination letters of support should clearly identify in detail how the nominee meets the following criteria:

How does this nominee demonstrate longstanding commitment to Internal Medicine? Please provide specific examples that demonstrate this nominee's contributions which should include a minimum of 2 of the following criteria:

- vignette or poster presentation at a local or national conference
- publication (s)
- student mentoring
- leadership and advocacy
- involvement in student interest groups, particularly internal medicine student interest group
- volunteer community service
- a commitment to patient care as demonstrated during clinical rotations or continuity clinic
