

## Vermont Medical Student and Resident/Fellow Poster Competition

We will host a Medical Student and Resident/Fellow Poster Competition at our 2019 annual Vermont Chapter Meeting at the Trapp Family Lodge in Stowe on Friday, October 11, 2019.

Abstracts will be accepted in 2 categories – clinical vignettes and research/quality/high value care. The winners in each category will receive support to attend and present at the national ACP Internal Medicine meeting in Los Angeles, CA from April 23-25, 2020. Abstract submission deadline is Sunday, September 1.

How to participate:

1. **Submit an abstract.** Send your abstract to Allen Repp by email **before midnight on Sunday, September 1** ([allen.repp@uvmhealth.org](mailto:allen.repp@uvmhealth.org)). Please submit the abstract in PDF or Word format. There is a 450 word limit (which includes headings, but not title, authors or references). Reminder: please send these in abstract form, not in poster form. Indicate your role (Medical Student or Resident/Fellow) and category (Clinical Vignette or Research/Quality/High Value Care). 2. Abstracts will be reviewed. If your abstract is selected for a poster presentation, you will be notified of acceptance by September 16.
3. If your abstract is selected for poster presentation:
  - a. **Register for the VT ACP Chapter meeting** at <https://www.acponline.org/about-acp/chapters-regions/united-states/vermont-chapter/news-meetings>.
  - b. **Create your poster** (in PowerPoint). See the ACP's guide to preparing a poster presentation at <https://www.acponline.org/membership/residents/competitions-awards/abstracts/preparing/poster>. The recommended poster size is 36x48 inches in landscape format.
  - c. **Print your poster.**
  - d. **Present your poster.** At the Vermont ACP Meeting, Trapp Family Lodge on Friday, **October 11**.

At the meeting, judges will select and announce a winning poster in each category.
