I'd like to personally invite you to participate in the **ACP Future I.M. Experience**, a 2-day free, virtual, educational event designed specifically for Resident and Student Members of the College to be held on Friday and Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The schedule contains a variety of unique educational experiences ranging from case-based clinical reasoning sessions and the medical knowledge –based quiz competition Doctor's Dilemma®, to a medically – themed team, based “escape room” learning session. The meeting will also feature the winners of the annual ACP abstracts and posters competition and include a session on how to pursue research interests as a trainee.
